Membership

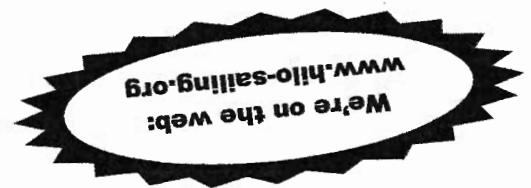
Memberships expired on 31 December as they do each year. So far we have 126 renewed and new 2007 family memberships. Check
